### **Kevin Hakeneis of Fulda, Minnesota**

- Kevin's dad, Keith, has been a carpenter for the past 26 years
- Kevin, age 14, was born with a deadly muscle condition called congenital fiber type disproportion, a disorder accompanied by significant breathing & swallowing difficulties. Many of these children don't survive infancy.
- Received deck/ramp, railing, and funds toward purchase of a wheelchair van

### **Adil Karamally of Anaheim, California**

- Adil owns a commercial mechanical contracting firm in Anaheim
- He suffered a major stroke at the age of 48
- Received a WalkAide system, an FDA approved system that leverages functional electrical stimulation to improve/enable walking ability

### **Melvin Baham of New Orleans, Louisiana**

- Melvin worked as a carpenter and general contractor for over 50 years
- Melvin lost his leg to diabetes and his wife was paralyzed when a blood clot developed on her spine
- The Baham's lost their house to hurricane Katrina, and subsequent efforts to rebuild were hampered by dishonest contractors and shoddy workmanship
- Foundation worked with St. Bernard project to provide handicapped entrance to home

### **Betty Jenkins of North Chesterfield, Virginia**

- Betty worked for 25 years as a receptionist and handled administrative and accounting functions for family owned construction firm
- Paralyzed at C4/C5 level in July 2007 from a fall
- Received bath remodel and ceiling Hoyer lift

### **Kenneth Gagot of Massapequa, New York**

- Kenneth was employed as a construction worker for 35 years
- Kenneth was paralyzed in spring 2014 at C5 level after falling off a ladder
- Received funds enabling purchase of wheelchair van
