While Covid 19 has certainly made a mess of things in 2020, you can still enjoy playing a round of golf by taking some common sense precautions. The RB Golf Course & Resort in Runaway Bay, Texas is hosting 10 charity golf tournaments to raise money for nonprofits in the Dallas-Fort Worth area affected by the pandemic. Runaway Bay is located about 75 miles west of McKinney on US 380, about 1.5 hours from most locations in the DFW area. The property is located on scenic Lake Bridgeport, on the far northern tip of the Texas Hill country. The course features abundant Live Oak trees, rolling hills and majestic lake views. This championship level course offers four sets of tees, stretching to 7000 feet from the tips.

This tournament is designed to help the foundation provide a grant to Donald Rindahl. Please see the Runaway Bay golf page on the foundation website for more information about Donald, and the grant that you can help provide by your participation in this tournament. **Golfer safety is paramount**, and toward that end, the following policies will be in effect to achieve that goal.

- [©] "Touchless" registration will be handled completely online
- Shamble format utilized to assist with golfer separation
- 🕴 One golf cart per household, or per golfer if desired
- Masks required in all indoor spaces at the golf course
- No group meals or gatherings at tournament, either indoors or outdoors
- Reduced public touch points throughout course include no flag removal and a hook on each hole to facilitate ball removal without reaching inside the cup with your hand
- All public touch points throughout the facility are regularly sanitized, including golf carts, restrooms, restaurant and the Pro shop
- 🕴 Outdoor dining tables and chairs available
- 🕴 Lunch will be provided at the turn, so as to minimize golfer congregation
- B Golf Course will follow all county and state mandates re-virus

The tournament will utilize a shamble format, whereby each golfer tees off, and the best drive is selected for the location of the second shot. From there, each golfer plays their own ball until it is holed out. The lowest individual score for that hole becomes the team score.

Tournament Details

- 1. There will be no check-in, golf begins at 9 AM.
- 2. Teams will consist of 3 or 4 people. If team has three people, group will rotate turns for fourth shot.
- 3. Sponsorships available include:
 - a. Eagle Sponsor ~\$1500 qualifies for two teams. Recognition at course, on foundation website for the next year and at next year's tournament.

- b. Prize Sponsor ~\$1200. Qualifies for one team. Recognition at course, on foundation website for the next year and at next year's tournament. Also includes 3 ea Mulligan's and raffle tickets +1 give a putt
- c. Birdie Sponsor ~\$1000. Qualifies for one team. Recognition at course, on foundation website for the next year and at next year's tournament.
- d. Par Sponsor ~\$500. Qualifies for two people. Recognition at course and at next year's tournament.
- e. Hole in One Sponsor ~\$500. Qualifies for two people. Recognition at course and at next year's tournament.
- f. Hole Sponsor ~\$200. Qualifies for one person. Recognition at course and at next year's tournament.
- g. Player ~\$150. Qualifies for participation in course contests, and opportunity for prizes and raffles. Complementary breakfast burritos available before golf, and choice of fresh grilled RB Burger or turkey, bacon sandwich for lunch at the turn. Beverages available in the clubhouse and on the course. Sleeve of balls included.

Prizes/Other Options Available

- A. Prizes for low score ~ first, second, and third place teams
- B. Prizes for hole in one on 4 par threes
- C. Mulligan's \$10 each. 3 Max/person; 12 Max/team
- D. Give a putt \$25. 1 Max/person; 4 Max/team (up to 20 feet)
- E. 50/50 Drawing \$20. Winner splits the pot with the foundation.
- F. Raffle prizes \$5 each. 10 prizes available.
- G. Winning team will be invited to compete for \$10,000 at the RB Charity 10 Invitational in October, 2020.
