### **Christine Faini of Framingham, Massachusetts**

- Christine's husband, Eugene, is a foreman for James W. Flett Company.
- She developed Necrotizing Autoimmune Myelopathy which caused paralysis and loss of bodily functions.
- Received a hospital bed, a ramp, a shower chair, bathroom modifications, and respiratory equipment

### **David Hartzheim of Dayton, Washington**

- David worked as a journeyman construction worker in Los Angeles, focusing on sheetrocking and taping.
- He became permanently disabled with Parkinson's and it affected his eyesight.
- Received funds for an eye procedure and custom prism lenses

### **Josh Hicks of Monroe, Georgia**

- Josh was self-employed as Josh Hicks Handyman Services.
- Began experiencing kidney and lung problems needing dialysis and oxygen.
- Received a portable oxygen tank and pickup truck to give him freedom of mobility

### **John Milligan of Cambridge, Ohio**

- John worked as a heavy equipment operator.
- A motor vehicle accident left him paralyzed from the waist down.

- Received a full HVAC installation in his brand new home

### **Frances Glueck of Columbus, Texas**

- Frances' father, Andrew, has been in the construction industry for over 20 years.
- She was born with a genetic condition that caused cognitive and physical disabilities.
- Their home was upgraded with an HVAC system and a walk in shower

### **Trevan Jones of McPherson, Kansas**

- Trevan was a young welder for a pipeline maintenance and construction company.
- He was involved in a motor vehicle accident in which he lost his leg.
- Received a bathroom renovation to help him become more self-sufficient

### **Joe Brunner of Osseo, Wisconsin**

- Joe was a finish carpenter for 15 years.
- He was paralyzed when he was riding a dirt bike in Clark County Forest and lost control.
- Renovations were donated to his home to make it more accessible

Advocating for pathways to affordable short/long-term disability insurance for employees of small businesses in the contracting industry

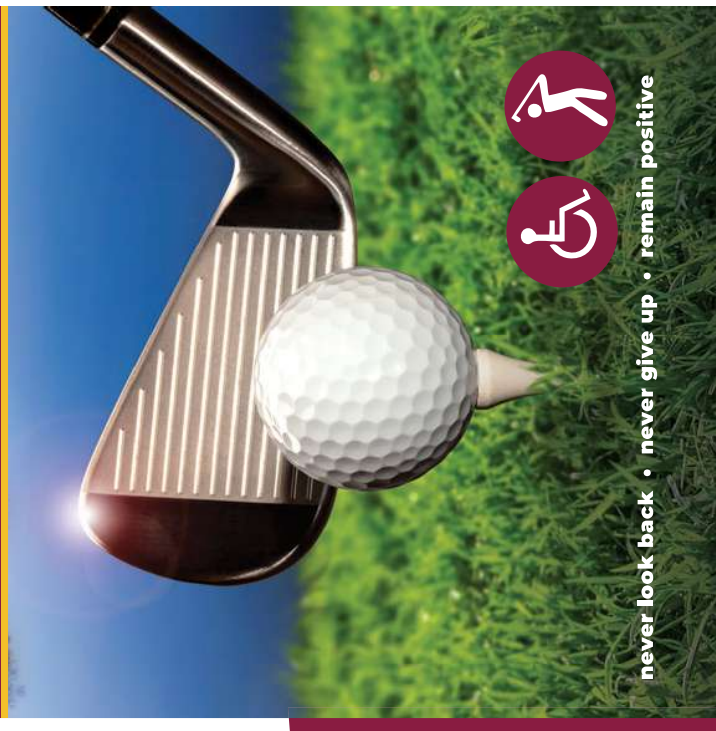
